Update: Olamide Adeyooye

According to Mississippi Highway Patrol and Newton County Sheriff's Office, a fire was reported on the morning of October 17th at a location off Highway 80, in Newton County Mississippi. On October 21st persons cleaning up the debris discovered the body of an unidentified black female. The Newton County Sheriff's Office was contacted to investigate along with the Mississippi Highway Patrol, who processed the scene.

On October 24th, the Normal Police Department was contacted by the Newton County Sheriff's Office. Based on this information, dental records were obtained and sent to a forensic dentist working with the Newton County Medical Examiner. On today's date we did receive confirmation that the body recovered in Newton County Mississippi is that of Olamide Adeyooye.

We continue to investigate individuals that may have been involved or have information regarding this case. We are still actively searching for her vehicle.
