Update: Olamide Adeyooye

Our investigation into the death of Olamide Adeyooye remains dynamic. This is a very complex case involving at least three states and many local, state and federal investigators. Interviews with individuals who may or may not have knowledge of this crime, and collected evidence continues to be evaluated. We are working with the Mississippi Medical Examiner to determine Olamide's cause of death.

The Atlanta FBI Office has completed their forensic investigation of Adeyooye's vehicle. Collected evidence will be analyzed at the Illinois State Police Crime Lab. We are arranging the transfer of the vehicle to the Normal Police Department. We are unable to release any information regarding evidence collected from the vehicle as it may harm the continuing investigation.

Based on information and evidence collected during this investigation we have reason to believe 27 year old Maurice Wallace of Normal is involved or has knowledge of the disappearance and death of Olamide Adeyooye. We are actively exploring all leads and information pertaining to this investigation.
